- 1996 – Produced and Managed '*Country Girls of the Cariboo*' Concert – Williams Lake Rodeo Association & City of Williams Lake, BC – 3,000 attendees
- 1999 – Began recording debut record in Vancouver, BC @ Magic Lab Studios with Producer, John MacArthur Ellis.
